Who can take part: All Vermont students in grades 9 through 12 (2021-2022 school year), including homeschooled students.

Submission categories: Fiction, non-fiction, and poetry. A panel of distinguished Vermont writers will judge entries in each category.

Awards, too! Winners in each category will receive \$500. First runners-up will receive \$100. Winners and first runners-up will also have the opportunity to publish their work in NVU's Green Mountains Review and the League's League Lines, and will receive a one-year membership in the League.

Contest details: The contest begins September 1, 2021. The deadline for entries is November 15, 2021. Winners will be announced on or about January 15, 2022. NVU will host a special, on-campus event to honor winners and first runners-up, and their schools, teachers, and families.
